RE: ANTH 64, 64X-Z Internship Courses Status

This memo is to formally inform the Anthropology Department and the Social Sciences and Humanities Division that the submission of the ANTH 64, 64X-Z (Anthropology Internships) was not approved by the State Chancellor's Office due to the courses being considered as cooperative work experience by the course reviewer. While our faculty curriculum initiator and the Curriculum Coordinator made several attempts to explain and show that these courses were not cooperative work experience courses, the State felt that the courses needed to be completely rewritten to show otherwise.

Additionally, these courses were also submitted as part of Anthropology ADT to be approved by the State. In order for the Anthropology ADT to be approved, the Curriculum Office had to remove the courses from the initial program submission. The removal of these courses did not adversely affect any unit values and/or requirements for the program.

The faculty curriculum initiator has been informed of the actions taken above by the Curriculum Office back in May 2017 and is aware that in order for the ANTH 64, 64X-Z (Anthropology Internship) courses to be reviewed and approved by the State, they will have to be rewritten and resubmitted in the future, per the college's curriculum processes and deadlines for new courses.
