- Julia passes gavel to Kevin.
- **Julia moves to add an amendment that Senators should have mandatory presentations in class about DASB, and there would be a ½ point consequence if you miss.**
- Motion dies.
- Jaymar argued that there are other, better ways to get the word out about DASB.
- Julia argued that this is the best way to connect to students.
- Pedro argued for the amendment, and said its not that many points if you miss all.
- Mehdi asked how could we be held accountable if this amendment passed?
- Julia answered that’s a good point. There may have to be other consequences.
- Mehdi said his professor wont let him speak let alone sign a paper confirming it.
- Hakwoo said you can do other classes, not your own. And he voiced that this might limit Senator’s creativity in reaching out to the Student Body.
- Julia says this is not asking for too much.
- Jaydeep supported that its only two minutes a week. Making something mandatory isn’t necessarily a bad thing.
- Melissa asked for clarification on Julia’s thinking behind “presentation”.
- Julia clarified that many of you are already doing this already, Marketing makes presentations, and other Senators do this during New Student Orientation.
- Rhea says it shouldn’t be limited to class presentations. If a Senator talks to other members in a day, shouldn’t this fulfill the requirement?
- Hakwoo asked, doesn’t this fall under “field hours”?
- Julia mentioned you can go in groups.
- Kandice agreed with Rhea that it shouldn’t be limited to classes, but it should include Clubs.
- Rebecca agreed but said perhaps instead of every week, make it two weeks.
- Jaydeep suggested the language would include must promote DeAnza to a group of ten or more people a week.
- Naeema said there are many avenues to connect with members.
- Tao and Naeema mentioned that SRS is working on event reflection document, and they recently
